Established in 1890 by Australian born brothers
Herbert & Frederick Kay the Heritage Listed
Kays Amery Winery celebrated the first grape
crush in 1895. The winery boasts some stunning
panoramic views of the surrounding picturesque
valleys and hillsides. The welcome at cellar door
is as friendly as the view is seductive. The main
grape variety grown is Shiraz (including the 1892
planted Block 6) followed by Cabernet Sauvignon,
Merlot, Viognier, Grenache, Mataro (Mourvedre) &
Muscat Blanc (Frontignac). Colin Kay's winemaking
philosophy is to make rich full-bodied fruit-driven
wines (using the original open fermenters and
basket press) with a minimum of 18 month small
American oak cask maturation.
