Weaving Stories Spinning Yarns

Workshops for children and families that explore dance, song and weaving.

\$25 per person each session

Thursday January 11th

10-12pm: Weaving stories with Inawinytji Williamson, Pitjantjatjara/Yankunytjatjara artist, dancer and Elder

You will produce either a fibre art animal using natural fibres and all manner of found things amidst “yarning and storytelling”!

1-3pm: Song and Dance with Inawinytji Williamson, Pitjantjatjara/Yankunytjatjara artist and Elder

Learn a song and dance in language (Pitjantjatjara/Yankunytjatjara), with body painting in traditional children’s and contemporary symbols and learn “to dance a story”.

Friday January 12th.

10-12pm: Janice Rigney, Buandig Elder from the Southern Elders Desert Weavers

Learn Buandig, Kurna and Ngarrindjeri weaving techniques using natural and manmade fibres including found and collected fibres from Red Poles land. Join the weaving circle and talk about country and life both past and present whilst producing a unique piece of culture from this South Australian region.

1-3pm: Janice Rigney, Buandig Elder from the Southern Elders Desert Weavers

Paint small canvas and/or beads using traditional and contemporary Indigenous patterns to create your own unique artwork and jewellery and listen to traditional stories about country.
